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Jerry Narcisi is a 1967 graduate of Shadyside High School. He received his Bachelor of Science Degree from Ohio University in 1971 in Engineering Technology and Management and his Master of Arts Degree in Vocational-Technical Education from The Ohio State University in 1974. He then completed additional coursework through Franciscan University to receive his Superintendent's Certificate in 1981.

Upon graduation from Ohio University in 1971, Jerry worked as an engineer in private practice and was also a part-time engineering instructor at Belmont Technical College and Ohio University. During his career he worked at Belmont Harrison Vocational School District as a teacher in 1971, Supervisor in 1975, Director in 1980, and Superintendent from 1981 – 1990. Jerry served as Superintendent of Schools for the Shadyside Local School District in 1990 until his retirement in 2006. In 2009 he served as the Interim Superintendent for the Bridgeport Exempted Village School District. He is currently working as a consultant in public education and school funding, part-time volunteer administrator for the Shadyside Local School District, part-time school funding consultant to several state organizations and local schools, and facilitator to several schools performing the Ohio Superintendent Evaluation System.

Jerry was a member of the former Bellaire-Shadyside Rotary and is a Paul Harris Fellow. He is an OHSAA Registered Track Official and Chairman of the Shadyside Relays Committee. Jerry is a member of the following boards and organizations: OVAC Executive Board and a Past President, OVAC Track Committee, Board of Directors at East Ohio Regional Hospital, Chairman of the Health Services and Education Corporation, Chairman of the Ohio University Eastern Regional Coordinating Council. He is a member of the Epsilon Pi Tau Professional Fraternity, Ohio University and Iota Lambda Sigma Professional Fraternity, The Ohio State University.

Jerry resides in Shadyside, Ohio with his wife, Karen. They are the proud parents of two children, Kevin and Jodi and three grandchildren, Gianna, Lily, Cami.



Samuel A. Mumley

1931 - 1999

For more than three decades, Samuel A. Mumley served the youth of this area as executive secretary of the Ohio Valley Athletic Conference. Sam was also a great member of the St. Clairsville Sunrise Rotary Club. He served for many years in the club and was the most active sheriff we had. He also worked on many community Rotary projects and was active as an Osiris Shriner.

Perhaps the greatest compliment one can pay Sam Mumley, following his passing, is to say that he made this world a much better place to live because he once walked among us.

Mumley devoted nearly five decades to working for the youth of our Ohio Valley. In addition to his time as executive secretary of the OVAC, which is still believed to be the largest high school athletic conference of its kind in the United States, Mumley was an athletic trainer, coach, basketball official, teacher and a school administrator.

If that wasn't enough time to give, Mumley joined Eric Carder, the assistant principal and director of activities at Wheeling Park High School, in serving as co-director for the West Virginia

Super Six state high school football championships.

He also helped raise hundreds of thousands of dollars for charitable organizations in the Ohio Valley over the past 26 years.


The scholarship program also has been enhanced by Sam's ability to involve the corporate sector of the various communities within the extensive OVAC map.

When important final decisions had to be made, Sam didn't mind being the one to make them. And of course, his main concern was making sure that the decisions were in the best interest of the OVAC student-athletes.

From a personal standpoint, if Sam became your friend, he was your friend for life. He was always there with a kind word, a bit of advice if it was asked for, and encouragement when any of his friends were in a difficult situation. Sam always said "Do It For The Kids"! Rotary believes in the same motto as Sam did.

A long bout with cancer terminated Mumley's life at the too young age of 67. But, as this writer has stated before, you won't make me believe "Sammy" lost that fight with cancer. Nothing defeated Sam Mumley in his lifetime. God, whom Sam believed in with all his heart, simply decided it was time to call him home.

The 5 K course is as follows: Beginning on Main St., east on Main St., left on N. Market St., pass the city bldg., left on Newell Ave., right on N. Market St., follow N. Market to its end at the ball fields, turn in to the ball fields and go to the pond, turn around and come back to the beginning of the bike trail, follow the trail through the tunnel to the gazebo, exit the trail at the gazebo, turn left on Sunset Dr., follow Sunset into Hutchinson Dr., turn right on Woodrow Ave., up Woodrow Ave. to Marietta St., turn left on Marietta St. and go to intersection with Main St., turn right onto Main St. and finish near the courthouse.
